

**CERT (Citizen Emergency Response Team)**

**Future Training**

CERT is a county wide volunteer group of trained citizens organized to assist police, fire, and administration in the advent of a community wide emergency. We presently have thirteen citizens trained, and we are accepting applications for future members who are interested.

Applicants must be eighteen years of age and must complete the County Emergency Management Agency courses. These consist of three evening classes, lasting four hours each. The courses cover organization, first aid, and related topics. You will be notified once the class dates have been established.

We have planned for training and information sessions for our local citizens, occurring two or three times a year. Members are entered onto the Summit County roster and may be called by the County EMA chapter should an emergency occur. Our Bath Township CERT group is dedicated to local emergencies, though the members may be called to action for other areas in the county.
