



Hammond's Corners**





# Cheese Factory

It appears that the cheese factory was likely built in the early 1870s by Allen Welton. Allen Welton (1809-1878) built the first cheese factory in the Peninsula area and later built a second cheese factory east of Hammond's Corners in Bath, which his son Frank helped him to conduct.


By 1890, he sold the property to Charles Joss.

That 1910 tax record that shows the cheese factory still on the property and Sigel Whitcraft owning the property with the old cheese factory and small house with slate roof noted.






















