A RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY REQUESTING THE SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL
OFFICER TO CALCULATE THE MILLAGE, EXPRESSED IN DOLLARS AND
CENTS FOR EACH ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS OF THE COUNTY
FISCAL OFFICER’S APPRAISED VALUATION FOR BATH TOWNSHIP’S
PROPOSED 2.0-MILL RENEWAL WITH A 1.4 MILL INCREASE FOR A COMBINED
3.4 MILLS TO THE ROAD AND BRIDGE LEVY #77 THAT EXPIRE DECEMBER 31,
2026 WITH COLLECTION THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2027. Amended
(ORC §5705.03 AND ORC §5705.25)

WHEREAS, the Bath Township Board of Trustees in its desire to make informed decisions for future planning of Bath Township, needs to know the amount of revenue a 2.0 mill levy renewal with 1.4 mill increase would generate; and,

WHEREAS, Bath Township has a current 1.4 mill Road and Bridge Levy along with a .6 mill Road and Bridge Levy that expire on December 31, 2026, with collection year through December 31, 2027; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees seeks to renew the existing 1.4-mill levy and .6 mill levy and to increase with a 1.4 mill levy on the November 3rd, 2026 general election ballot for the purpose of the operation and maintenance of the Bath Township Road and Bridge system and capital projects in accordance with R.C. 5705.19(G) and R.C. 5705.25 and presented to and levied upon the entire territory within Bath Township, Summit County, Ohio;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Bath Township Board of Trustees hereby requests that the Summit County Fiscal Officer calculate said millage expressed in dollars and cents for each one hundred thousand dollars of the county auditor’s appraised valuation for a 1.4 mill renewal, .6 mill renewal and a 1.4 mill increase to the Road and Bridge levy for a period of five years for tax year 2027 and collection year beginning in 2028.

AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE JACKSON TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND
THE BATH TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

This agreement is entered into this 6th day of July 2026 by and between the Jackson Township Police Department, (hereinafter referred to as "**JACKSON**", and the Bath Township Police Department (hereinafter referred to as "**BATH**")

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, The Jackson Township Trustees have authorized the Jackson Township Police Department to conduct Cryptocurrency Investigations; and,

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed that The Jackson Township Police Department may investigate Cryptocurrency cases originating in the Bath Township Police Department jurisdiction and Jackson Township Police Department will share in forfeited assets as outlined below.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

SERVICES: **JACKSON** agrees to have a certified Cryptocurrency Investigator assigned to investigate cases shared with them by **BATH**. The results of these investigations will be reported as completed, and reports can be requested as needed, in writing, through the designated liaison officer.

FACILITIES: **JACKSON** recognizes and agrees that its facilities will be used in the execution of this agreement. **JACKSON** also recognizes that these types of investigations can be done remotely and may be done at other facilities if agreed upon.

DUTIES AND SUPERVISION: In the performance and execution of all duties and responsibilities of a law enforcement officer, the assigned Jackson Officer will be under the control, direction, and authority of **JACKSON**. The assigned Jackson Officer will remain under their current supervision and will only act as a liaison between the **JACKSON** and **BATH**.

FORFEITURE SHARING: This agreement is to be used to establish jurisdiction and to specify forfeited asset sharing. Forfeited assets will be divided in the following order ***after the victim has had their property returned*** and other victims have been attempted to be located:

- 1) 80% will remain with **JACKSON**
- 2) 20% will be disbursed to **BATH**

DURATION AND TERMINATION: This agreement shall be effective for one (1) calendar year from the date of signing.

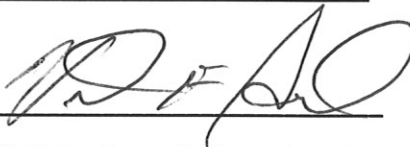
Either party to this agreement may terminate this agreement with a thirty (30) day written notice of termination by either party to the other party. Notice of termination must be made by certified, return receipt mail.
