## Bath Township Museum hosted Veterans' Day Recognition Open House

The 2025 Museum exhibit features Mills and Industries of Early Bath Township. On November 9, the Museum hosted an open house for all Veterans to view some of the many military uniforms and artifacts in the BTHS collection. These items will be part of the exhibit for the rest of this year and many will be used in the 2026 exhibit. The museum is open Monday and Wednesday mornings 9:00-11:00 am and Sunday afternoons 1:00 to 4:00 pm. Admission is free, donations are appreciated.



This exhibit will be open until Sunday, December 28, 2025. The Museum will then close until March 1, 2026, to create the new exhibit celebrating America 250. Come by to view local history at its finest!

The 2026 exhibit will feature the daily lives of Bath Township citizens as they share the American experience in celebration of 250 years as a nation. The Museum will display clothing, artifacts, maps, flags, and photographs to show what was happening locally and nationally during each era.
